Before walking out the door of her home, little Alexandra stops and looks down at her worn pair of sandals. Should she wear them today?

This is her only pair of shoes, and they are already falling apart. She decides she can't risk breaking them while she is playing with her friends. She turns and walks out the door barefoot.

In Africa and the Caribbean, walking is how children get around. Children living in poverty walk for miles each day just to collect water or go to school, yet many of them have no shoes to protect their feet. If they do have shoes, they are flimsy sandals or flip flops, often worn for many years or handed down from older siblings.

A new pair of shoes is a life-changing gift for a child like Alexandra. With a gift of \$24, you'll give two children their own pair of sturdy shoes.

As the sun blazes overhead, Alexandra picks her way carefully over the hot, sharp gravel. Ouch!

She holds her foot in her hand so she can examine it. There's a piece of glass wedged in the bottom of her foot, and the cut is starting to bleed. She closes her eyes and picks out the glass before continuing on.

It's not just inconvenient for children to walk around barefoot—it's painful and dangerous. They walk on dirt and gravel roads with sharp rocks and broken glass. In some areas, there are parasites living in the soil. Many

This small gift changed Alexandra's life. She no longer has to worry about getting injured every time she walks out the door. She can run and play in shoes that won't break or slip off her feet. She can hold her head high. Every day, her feet are protected.


