going to school, but she kept having to miss class.

"When I got sick, I was not able to go to school because I was weak and feeling pain, so I was not able to go until I was feeling better. I was missing a lot, because when I got sick I would stay home one week each time." Malaria can cause fever, fatigue, chills, vomiting, and more.
